



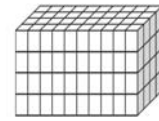
Board Approves 2007 Textbook Adoption

Instructional Focus Brookhollow Elementary

Brookhollow Elementary presented an instructional focus on the math concept of volume. This subject was previously introduced in 5th grade; however, new revisions to the TEKS require 3rd and 4th to also investigate this concept. Brookhollow's Student Council used models of cubic units to show Board Members how volume is introduced in 3rd grade, expanded in 4th grade and tested in 5th grade.

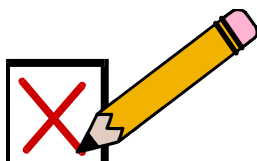
